SRC Fundraiser - Buy A Bale



A big thank you must go to the school community for supporting this worthy fundraising cause. Our SRC initiated fundraiser raised \$610 for this campaign run by Rural Aid. Our school's efforts will contribute to supporting the drought affected farming regions.

What do our fundraising efforts go to?

 $Hay - 5 \times 20 bales feeds **One** cow for **One** Week

Diesel – Every \$4.40 transports hay one km anywhere in Australia.

Water – Every \$250 delivers 11,500 litres delivered to a farm within 100 km of the collection point

\$5700 buys a single-trailer load of hay

\$9500 buys a semi-trailer load of hay and transports it to an affected area. (up to 900 km)
