- * Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- * Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
- * Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.

- * Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game. Positive comments are motivational.
- * Applaud good performance and efforts from each team and congratulate all participants on their performance regardless of the game's outcome.

- * Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators for without them, your child could not participate.
- * Do not publicly question the officials' judgement and never their honesty. If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels in writing rather than questioning the officials' judgement and honesty in public.
